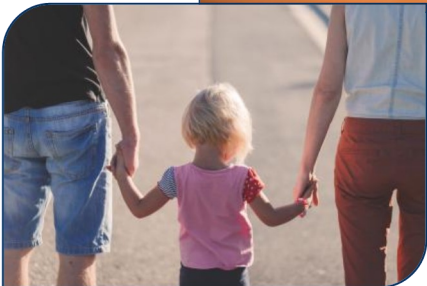


CalWORKs Family Stabilization Services

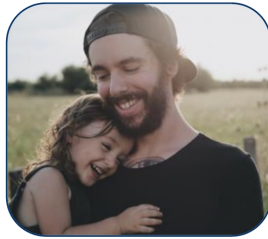

We're Here To Help

The CalWORKs Behavioral Health program offers a variety of services to help you become self-sufficient to take care of your family and reduce barriers to employment. Our professional staff will assist you in identifying goals and help you build bridges to reach them. CalWORKs has offices located throughout Riverside County.



Eligibility

You must be participating in a Department of Public Social Services (DPSS) CalWORKs program to be eligible for CalWORKs Behavioral Health services. Contact your local GAIN office for further details if you are interested in services.



Requesting Services

There are several options available. Complete an application online or visit one of the CalWORKs offices (website and office locations on reverse side).

Any DPSS CalWORKs customer that is requesting mental health services can be referred to CalWORKs.

If participating in a CalWORKs program you may self refer by contacting your local GAIN office.

CalWORKs Mental Health
