

City of Riverside Office of Homeless Solutions: The City of Riverside has long been addressing homelessness and has modeled the various ways cities can use federal, state, and local funds to implement a Comprehensive System of Care. Through the use of data and the delivery of outreach, case management, shelter and wraparound supportive services, the City's Housing Authority has successfully created innovative permanent housing solutions. With an emphasis on regional collaboration, the City has emerged as a leader in modeling best practices to address homelessness from a municipal framework.
